Felix Family in Africa

The first African Felix village

We are approaching Christmas again and our work on the ground in Africa has intensified. The first African Felix village has blueprints drawn up, and we are overwhelmed by the positive response we get from the potential partners and churches we are working with. In January we have our next sit-down with some of them to lay the final plans for exactly where we start building. Vulnerable children are vulnerable wherever they are, they all deserve to be treated with dignity. They have rights. As we do this, we need your support. Currently we need money to pay for land, and for the construction of the houses. Our

plans are to build along the same general model as we have done in Romania and Thailand, with vocational training and farming to become more self-sustainable. If you have any ideas for how you can support this with ideas, contacts or money - thank you! Whatever you give makes a big difference!

Feeding program

Just like we did when we started in Romania 23 years ago, we have set up a feeding program. We



obviously fundraise for this separately from sponsor money, and we can see that it has exactly the same impact in Africa as it did in Romania. Hungry families are vulnerable families. The effect on children is compounded many times. We are currently feeding hungry children in an area called Taita Taveta where the local community is exposed to changes in weather patterns, poor harvests and seasonal extreme hunger.
