Felix Family Village Ministries build real families. A Felix family, as all other families, is established and lives together for life. The family grows up together, and learns to love and respect one another, and the little ones understand the importance of mom, dad and family for their own lives. The Felix Ministries have found that twelve young ones per family is a good number. It gives the parents time for each and everyone - and that is the purpose. The parents live only for that. There is normally no refilling of little babies when the family grows older.

But the last two years a growing number of children have been left on the streets again, or in institutions. There are more than 150 000! Many Ministries have in the strained financial times gone bankrupt and the little ones have been transferred to horrendous institutions and left alone. So Caminul Felix parents and the leaders in Romania have decided to open their lives and homes for more children. The last 10 months around 60 new children have been received into the homes that have the facilities for it. Extraordinary conditions call on extraordinary actions.
