There is lots of work before having milk on the table, and for this we are thankful to dr. Florin Beteg and his team for providing this.


It quite a complex operation even the calves and cows are looking simple and cute.

EXPANSION & DEVELOPMENT

The operations of Felix are spread across several continents, and even though there are big cultural differences between Eastern Europe, Far East Asia and East Africa, the fundamentals are the same. Children are abandoned during tragic events, and they are left to fend for themselves. They are

always stigmatised, and they never receive enough love and enough material support to be safe.

At Felix we work to meet the physical, spiritual, emotional and social needs of these orphaned and abandoned children, and we do so in a loving family setting.

Our Romanian villages have seen several generations of children grow up in a safe and sound family setting. Romania is still grappling with large marginalised groups, and the problem with abandoned children persists. Our village in Thailand is growing, and is nearing completion. We are looking at expanding into Bangladesh with a village, and we have since a few years been supporting poor children in Kenya.

Our job will never stop. But instead of feeling overwhelmed by the sheer size of the problem, we know that every time we can help one child, we have been part of a miracle. We thank God for that, and we thank you for your support in making it happen.
